

**STUDENT PARKING FEES**

It is the policy of the Buncombe County Board of Education that fees for student parking be charged, and high schools are authorized to charge a fee to be approved by the Board annually.

In the interest of safety, the principal may limit the number of student cars that may be parked on school grounds.

The principal may also determine, within the limits of law, how to deal with parking policy offenders. Parking in designated spaces without a permit will be considered a violation of both the local school's regulations and the Buncombe County Board of Education's policy. The violator may be punished under the individual school's disciplinary plan and/or by revocation of his parking privileges. The principal has the right to have cars towed when drivers violate the local school parking regulations.

Local school parking regulations will be made known annually to all students, faculty, and staff members.
